2009:

- Competed in 2 USAC Ford Focus Midget races with **2 top-4 finishes**
- 3rd place - first Midget race in two years at Kil-Kare Speedway (Xenia, Ohio)
- **Tested USAC National Midget** for Cunningham Motorsports Development team

2010:

- Secured four-race deal driving for Bob East in USAC Midgets (4 top-10 and 2 podium finishes)
- 7th in first USAC Regional Midget race at the Indianapolis Speedrome
